- Clients live in a home with no vehicle;
- Clients have a car that is too old and unreliable to travel long distances;
- Clients have a car that cannot accommodate their child's needs, such as a wheelchair; or
- Clients have one car that must be used for transportation to work, and client is unable to take leave.
