



WACF awards more than \$1 million in our Fall 2022 Grant Cycle.

The investment the **WALKER AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION** makes in our community is important to overall community health. The Foundation recently awarded **\$1,072,567** to the following organizations:

Alabama Association of Nonprofits (AAN) is the only association of its kind in Alabama dedicated exclusively to serving the nonprofit sector. Currently, there are more than 20 nonprofit leaders from Walker and Winston counties who turn to AAN for professional development courses, advocacy events and speaking engagements. A grant for the program supports advertising, training, technology/communications, contract workers, events and a website rebuild. *CF*

A grant to **Alabama Possible** supports personnel, outreach/marketing, and their Cash for College and Alabama College Application Week programs. Cash for College mobilizes students to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and Alabama College Application Week's goal is to increase the number of students from low-income families, first-generation students, and students of color to pursue postsecondary education by waiving application fees. *CF, LF, DDFF*

The **American Cancer Society's** Joe Lee Griffin Hope Lodge improves the quality of life and survivorship outcomes of cancer patients undergoing active cancer treatment by providing free, supportive lodging. A grant supports 154 nights of lodging. *CF, DTSF, LDFF, LF*

Better Basics, Inc. works to eradicate illiteracy among children in Central Alabama. A grant to the Dolly Parton Imagination Library – which has impacted more than 1,000 Walker County children – provides books monthly to children ages 0-5. *CF, GF, LDFF, LF, RFF*

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Greater Birmingham creates and supports one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth. A grant supports outreach, recruitment, enrollment, student and volunteer matching, background screening and training. *CF*

Camp McDowell's Farm School is a residential farm program that helps students connect to the natural world and the foods they eat. A grant supports scholarships for up to 300 Walker County children and more than 90 Winston County children. *CF, BF, DDFF, RFF*



A grant to **Children's Aid Society of Alabama** supports at least four (4) Trafficking-Free Zones in Walker County. The mission is to rescue and restore child victims of sex trafficking through development of uniform response protocols, training, and strategic partnerships that mobilize Alabama communities to prevent abuse, raise awareness, and increase safety. *CF, RCJF*

Children's Hospital of Alabama's Psychiatric Intake Response Center – who has a network of 1,600 mental health care providers – guides adult callers to the best course of care for the child or adolescent in need. A grant supports operating costs of the team of specialized mental health clinicians who staff the call center. *CF, DDFF, DTSF, LF*

Glenwood, Inc. seeks to become the premier provider of autism and behavioral health services in Alabama through professional collaboration, superior programming and evidence-based services for children and adults. A distribution grant was allocated for budget relieving purposes. *PDDF*

A grant to **Habitat for Humanity of Greater Birmingham** supports their Fortified Roof Project – which plans to restore up to 20 Walker County roofs. *CF, DDFF, RCJF, KUBF*

Kid One Transport System, Inc. provides transportation five (5) days a week for children and expectant mothers who have little or no means of transportation to needed medical care. A grant supports vehicle insurance, fuel, outreach, supplies and a driver. *CF, RCJF, LDFF, PBF*

A grant to **Magic Moments** supports Disney vacations for children who suffer from chronic life-threatening illnesses. *CF, BF, RLBF, SBFF, LF*

A grant to **Mission of Hope** supports their Christmas Toy Giveaway that plans to impact up to 100 children. *CF, BF, GF, RCJF, KUBF, LF, PBF*

HARTT, Inc. (Healing and Responding to Trauma) creates a trauma informed and resilience focused mental health service system to respond to and support the emotional and psychological needs of children in Walker and surrounding counties. A grant supports salaries, wages and expenses. *CF, BF, DDFF, DTSF, GF, LDFF, LF, PDDF, RFF, TDLF*

Sight Savers America provides the early detection and treatment of children's – and adult's – vision and health issues to help each child reach their full potential in the classroom and beyond. A grant supports vision screening events, children's follow up eye care and child / adult low vision and blind aids. *CF, BF, DDFF, RCJF, PBF, RFF*

Smile-A-Mile's mission is to provide hope, healing of the spirit and love for the whole family during the childhood cancer journey. A grant supports medical staff, materials and supplies, special activities, and the bereavement support group. *CF, RCJF, LF*

STEPS Ministries builds a movement in Walker County to prevent teenage addiction. A grant supports program management, digital outreach and marketing, training, and seminars. *CF, RLBF, SBFF*

A grant to **The Foundry Ministries** supports curriculum expenses, drug testing, groceries, salaries, transportation, supplies, software, housing, utilities, insurance, and security. The organization offers participants an individualized, comprehensive plan of care to overcome addiction and achieve post-recovery success. *CF, BDTF, DDFF, LDFF, LF*

The Willow Project exists to be a hub of hope within a community; to see transformation through relational, creative, and social justice initiatives. The organization offers piano, voice, guitar, dance, painting, cooking, pottery, education, sport training and many more avenues. A grant supports operational costs. *CF, GF, LF*

The **Town of Parrish** received a grant to repair the roof and remove trees at the Parrish Community Center – old high school. *CF, BF, DDFF, DTSF, PBF*

United Way of Central Alabama works with private, public, and nonprofit partners to boost education, economic mobility, and health resources. Distribution grants were allocated for operating expenses. *BF, TDLF*

A grant to the **Walker County Arts Alliance** supports youth arts education initiatives, theater performances, Art in the Park Festival, art gallery, marketing/promotional products. The goal of the organization is to engage all aspects of the community in the process of artistic expression. *CF, BF, LDFF, PBF, TDLF*



Wild Alabama's mission is to inspire people to enjoy, value, and protect the wild places of Alabama. A grant supports salaries, travel, rent and utilities. *CF, BF, DDFF, KUBF*

Yerkwood Community Improvement Association strives to instill a positive life in its community through food, afterschool, and summer school programs. A grant supplies office material. *CF, DTSF, LDFF, LF*

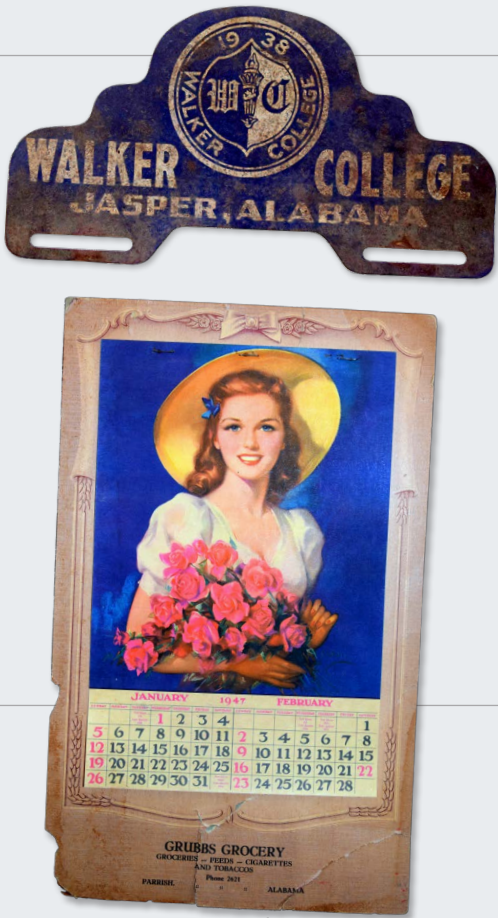
